

HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER OF THE NJ WORKFORCE REGISTRY

- 1. Go to www.njccis.com.
- 2. Click on the white **Log In** button in the upper right corner of the screen, then click on the blue **Register** button in the upper right corner of the Log In box.
- 3. Fill in the requested information then click on the blue **Register** button in the lower right corner.
- 4. An email will be sent to the email address that you registered with from no-reply@njccis.com. Open that email and click the link in the email to activate your account. You will be returned back to the Login page. Enter your email address (email address that you registered with) and password (the one you just created).
- 5. Click the **Log In** button to gain access to NJCCIS. You will be prompted to fill out your profile. Please complete your profile, or you will be prompted to do this every time you log in.

WORKSHOP REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- 1. Go to www.njccis.com and log in to your account.
- 2. Click on the Registry tab and choose Find Professional Development & Training Classes.
- 3. Click on the blue **Advanced Search** button on the right side, near the bottom of the screen.
- 4. Choose **Training Agency** in the drop down box under **Select Field to Search**. Then choose **Burlington County Community Action Program (BCCAP)** under **Training Agency**. Click the **Search** button.
- 5. Click on **Start Date** in the menu bar of the trainings, to order them by date.
- 6. Click on the blue pencil icon to the left of the training you're registering for.
- 7. Scroll down and click on the white **Register for this Event** button. You will then be asked to confirm that you are registering for this event. Repeat steps 6 and 7 to register for multiple workshops.
- 8. If you cannot attend a workshop you registered for, log back in, click on the Registry tab, and choose **My Events**. Click on the blue pencil icon to the left of the training you're withdrawing from. Scroll down and click on the white **Cancel registration from this event** button. Failure to withdraw from two workshops will prohibit you from enrolling in future workshops, as set up by the Registry. Also, withdrawals can be made up to 24 hours in advance.

10-hour Health & Safety Training

This health and safety orientation module provides an overview of the basic **health and safety** requirements and best practices in nine of the topic areas outlined in the CCDF Final Rule: safe spaces; transportation safety; handling and storage of hazardous materials; emergency preparedness; prevention and control of infectious diseases; food and allergic reactions and how to respond; administration of medication; shaken baby syndrome/abusive head trauma; safe sleep and SUIDS prevention.

Also, child care professionals are responsible for environments, experiences and interactions that help all children in child care thrive and reach their potential. The challenge is for the child care provider to demonstrate how to meet the **developmental needs of children** of many different ages. In this module, providers can learn predictable ways that children change and learn new skills over time, to give the provider a solid foundation for daily practice and decision-making.

Finally, **Mandated Reporting** is designed for child care staff, teachers, directors and family child care providers, will provide an overview of the significant definitions, requirements and policies outlined in the NJ Office of Licensing Manual of Requirements for Child Care Centers and Manual of Requirements for Family Child Care Registration related to Mandated Reporting and Positive Discipline. By the end of this training, participants will be able to: understand the types of child abuse & neglect; recognize signs of child abuse & neglect; understand NJ's requirements for Mandated Reporting; understand how and when to report; and create and implement an organization-specific policy on reporting procedures.

Providers can register for the modules needed if they haven't taken them online. Trainings are free, and will take place at the Human Services Building, 795 Woodlane Road, Westampton. *Please note that all ten hours are required by the state for providers who accept child care subsidy payments.*

ASQ-3 Developmental Screening Tool Tuesday, July 24, 2018 5:30pm – 8:30pm Free

For staff working with Infants and Toddlers Birth-36 months & Family Child Care Providers

During this half-day workshop, participants will learn about the importance and purpose of developmental screening for young children through hands-on use of the Ages and Stages Questionnaire-3 (ASQ-3). Early childhood educators and care providers will define and discuss the domains and features of this evidence-based developmental screening tool; practice administering, scoring, and interpreting results of the ASQ-3; and discuss methods of sensitively communicating results and talking with families about community referrals.

Safe Medication Administration in Child Care Settings Training Monday, July 30th and Tuesday, July 31st 6:00pm to 9:00pm \$10.00

This training will incorporate AAP HEALTHY FUTURES - five modules, which include information on preparing, administration and documenting medication in early education and child care settings. In this training, participants will learn how to safely administer medications to children, key information that should be included in medication polices, when medication should be given, and how to respond to inappropriate requests from parents regarding administering medication. Participants will also learn special needs care plans, how to recognize signs and symptoms of an asthma episode, asthma medication delivery systems, signs and symptoms of a life threatening allergic reaction and how to administer an Epi-Pen to a child in an emergency. This training is divided into 2 sessions and will start promptly at 6:00PM. Participants must register for <u>BOTH</u> evening trainings to receive credit and certification.
