Why It's Important

Simple matching games provide young children with the opportunity to practice matching similar objects.

Materials

A simple matching game

What You Do

- 1. Sit at a low table with the matching game. Show your child the game and invite her to join you.
- 2. Explain that there is a picture on each card and that her job is to find the ones that match.
- 3. As she picks up each card, describe the picture on it or ask her to describe it to you. *What do you see on that card? You found a blue duck.*
- 4. Encourage her to find the matching card. Can you find the other blue duck?
- 5. You can make the game more challenging by increasing the number of items to be matched.
- 6. Allow your child to play the matching game for as long as she is interested. Make the game available for your child to explore later as she chooses.
