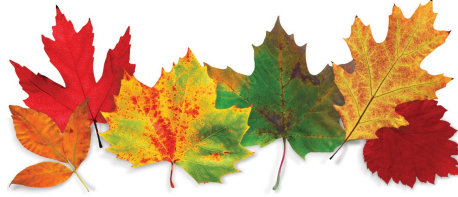


Family Child Care Newsletter


