Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Center for Community and Support Services

# **Housing Programs**

**Foreclosure Prevention Program** Center for Community and Support Services



BCAP provides free foreclosure prevention and intervention services to eligible homeowners. Services include foreclosure mitigation counseling and mortgage assistance to eligible

homeowners who are in danger of foreclosure as a direct result of unemployment or underemployment.

**Homelessness Prevention Program** Center for Community and Support Services

BCAP provides financial assistance to residents who are behind in their rent, facing eviction, or are homeless and in need of rental assistance to secure permanent housing.

**Permanent Supportive Housing** Center for Community and Support Services

BCAP provides safe, decent, and affordable permanent housing with supportive services to low-income families to help the participants achieve self-sufficiency and remain in permanent housing.

**Housing Counseling Program** Center for Community and Support Services

As a HUD approved housing counseling agency, BCAP provides first-time homebuyer education, pre-purchase and post-purchase homeownership counseling and mortgage delinguency and default resolution counseling. BCAP also provides fair housing assistance, renter assistance counseling, and assistance with locating affordable housing.
