### Child Care Resource and Referral Programs (CCR&R)

#### ***Child Care Resource and Referral Program Childcare office***

BCCAP provides free referrals and educational materials to families looking for a child care setting. We also provide training to parents and providers to help maintain quality child care in Burlington County.

#### ***Family Child Care Human Services Facility - 2nd Floor***

BCCAP administers Family Child Care (FCC) registration for residents of Burlington County. Our early childhood professionals perform inspections and provide technical assistance at the provider's home.

#### ***New Jersey Cares for Kids (NJCK) Subsidy Program Childcare Office***

NJCK is a subsidized child care program that assists low income families who work full time, attend school full time, or a combination of employment and schooling that equals full time hours to afford the cost of child care.

#### ***Work First New Jersey (WFNJ) Program Human Services Facility - 2nd Floor***

WFNJ is a subsidized child care program for families who received TANF in the past two years and are working or in an approved work activity.

**Healthy Families - TIP Program**  
*Human Services Facility - 2nd Floor*

The Healthy Families-TIP Program is a free parenting and support program that offers services to any parent residing in Burlington County, regardless of income, who is either pregnant or has a child 2 months old or less.



**Parents as Teachers (PAT) Program**  
*Human Services Facility - 3rd Floor*  
The Parents as Teachers (PAT) Program is a free parenting and support program that offers services to any parent residing in Burlington County, regardless of income, who is either pregnant or has a child 3 years old or less. Monthly group meetings are also offered.

Home Energy Programs

**Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program**  
*Center for Community and Support Services*

LIHEAP assists low-income families with their heating costs during the winter months and individuals with a medical need for cooling with their cooling costs. During emergency season, assistance is provided for those who have a balance owed and are at risk of having their services shut off.



**Universal Service Fund (USF)**  
*Center for Community and Support Services*

The USF Program helps make electric and natural gas bills more affordable for low income families by receiving a credit on the monthly bill.

Housing Programs

**Foreclosure Prevention Program**  
*Center for Community and Support Services*



BCAP provides free foreclosure prevention and intervention services to eligible homeowners. Services include foreclosure mitigation counseling and mortgage assistance to eligible

homeowners who are in danger of foreclosure as a direct result of unemployment or underemployment.

**Homelessness Prevention Program**  
*Center for Community and Support Services*

BCAP provides financial assistance to residents who are behind in their rent, facing eviction, or are homeless and in need of rental assistance to secure permanent housing.

**Permanent Supportive Housing**  
*Center for Community and Support Services*

BCAP provides safe, decent, and affordable permanent housing with supportive services to low-income families to help the participants achieve self-sufficiency and remain in permanent housing.

**Housing Counseling Program**  
*Center for Community and Support Services*

As a HUD approved housing counseling agency, BCAP provides first-time homebuyer education, pre-purchase and post-purchase homeownership counseling and mortgage delinquency and default resolution counseling. BCAP also provides fair housing assistance, renter assistance counseling, and assistance with locating affordable housing.
